The Tasting Lounge hours will be from 4 to 8 p.m. on Thursday, June 21, 5 to 9 p.m. on Friday, June 22, 3 to 10 p.m. on Saturday, June 23 and 3 to 8 p.m. on Sunday, June 24. Tasting Flights which will include five tastes will be \$5 and beer or wine by the glass will be \$6.
